

The Black List of German physicians and healthcare managers.

The goal of the Black List is to warn the public. The Black List contains the names of physicians and high level public and private healthcare managers who refuse to provide honest information and remedial medical care to victims of medical errors and their relatives. This refusal constitutes serious criminal offenses.

SIN-NL has registered Prof. M. Samii and Dr. M. Tatagiba on the Black List.

With this list SIN-NL wants to draw attention to the emergency situation of victims of medical errors and to draw attention to those who are responsible for the unnecessary sufferings of these patients.

September 25th 2009 the Court of Justice in Groningen (Netherlands) has permitted that SIN-NL publishes the Black List of physicians and healthcare managers on the internet.

SIN-NL strives for registration, research, prevention of medical errors as well as for open disclosure and adequate remedial medical care for victims of medical errors.

SIN-NL demands that physicians fulfil their ethical, professional and legal obligations towards victims of medical errors and thus provide honest information and adequate remedial medical care.

Criteria for registration on the Black List for physicians and healthcare managers:

- refusal of honest diagnostic examinations
- refusal of honest information
- refusal of adequate remedial medical care
- gross medical negligence and maltreatment of victims of medical care and their relatives
- refusal to develop statutory regulations to improve the situation of victims of medical errors.

Removal from the Black List is possible after providing honest information, adequate remedial medical care and eventual financial compensation. Moreover it is important to register, research and prevent medical errors.

Registration on the Black List is possible after sending a report and after careful examination.
